OUR LAND CALLED KALALAK



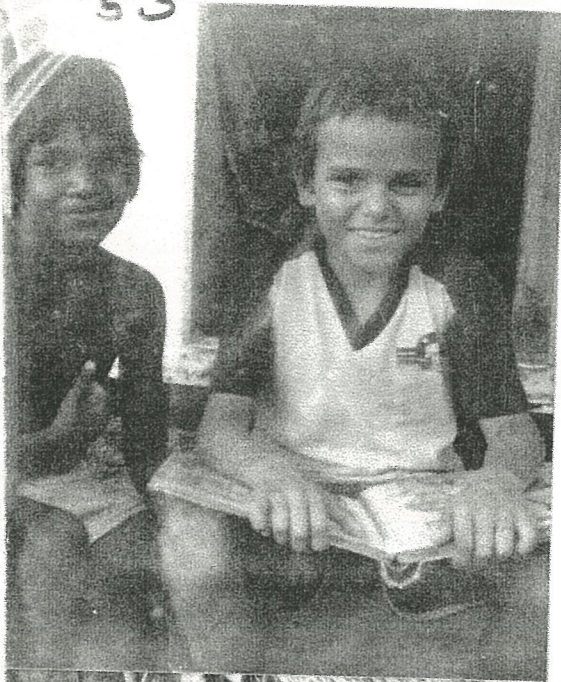
